The reconciliation of work and family life is difficult for Junior Doctors all over Europe. The problems are manifold. They range from the absence of sufficient part-time training positions, to a lack of affordable child care facilities with flexible opening hours to discriminating behaviour of employers towards Junior Doctors with small children. A recent German survey with 2,117 participating doctors revealed that 42% of the doctors were dissatisfied with the way they can combine work and family life. Another German study amongst medical students showed that only 3,6% of the participants thought that it is advisable to have children during postgraduate training.


